Falls sports have returned! The Sequim School District and Port Angeles School District share a unified voice regarding guidelines for spectators while cheering on our teams this season. In-person spectatorship is possible due to your cooperation in following the required safety protocols outlined below.

While attending school sporting events, all spectators must comply and honor these safeguards that include but are not limited to:

- Follow occupancy allowances.
- Masking is required for all spectators attending indoor and outdoor school sporting activities, regardless of vaccination status.
- Audience members should be seated or stand in "family units." Those small groups should space at least 3 feet apart.
- Student sections will be allowed with masks on and 3 feet of distancing.

Thank you for following these protocols 100%. We know how important it is to see your students play, and with your help, we can continue to offer in-person spectators. We take the health and safety of our student-athletes, staff, and spectators very seriously. Failure to comply with these required safety protocols could result in the loss of spectators to upcoming events.
