Off and Away – At the elementary level our practice has always been that all toys and any electronics stay off and in backpacks. We appreciate your proactive parenting in helping your student(s) to apply this district wide rule.

Students & Parking Lot Safety – To keep students safe we ask that cars drive through our pick-up line. Going slow and practicing patience and courtesy to all Haller Drivers is excellent modeling for our students. Parking on Fir St. and students walking to a car in line is dangerous and prohibited. Pick up takes place in the parking lot via car or a parent walking in. Thank you for keeping our students safe!

Another Pick-Up Option – The Boys and Girls Club is right next door and we have many families that skip the pick-up line. Instead they have their student(s) go to The Club and pick them up sometime between 3:15 – 6:00 p.m. when the traffic and wait time is minimal. Teachers walk students to our gym and Club staff walk them to The Club. There is also a snack at The Club.

Lunch and Recess – Each grade level has a 20 minute lunch and a 15 minute recess scheduled. If your student feels like they need more time to finish lunch they are welcome to stay in to finish up and then head out to recess. All staff will be informed of this option. We appreciate the grace while we refine our systems.

Picture Day


Picture Day will be Tuesday, September 19th
